Cross Infection Policy: Due to the risk of cross-infection between those who have Cystic Fibrosis, the CFTrust has produced the following guidelines for outdoor events.

1. Those with Burkholderia cepacia should not attend any event where others with CF may be present.
2. Others with CF may attend at their own discretion but should observe the following rules:
 - a) Do not travel to and from the event with others with CF.
 - b) Observe good basic hygiene, such as hand washing.
 - c) Do not shake hands with others with CF. A friendly pat on the shoulder is a good substitute.
 - d) Do not go into the pub or the restaurant after the event if there may be others with CF.
 - e) Whilst participating in or attending the outdoor event, do not get in close proximity with others unless you are sure they do not have CF.

We are sorry for any inconvenience or upset that this may cause. However the safety and well being of those with CF is our main concern, and we do not wish to expose anyone to unnecessary risk.
